This New Year has begun and before you know it will be summer. We are so excited about this years program that we are informing you of what we have planned and are offering you the opportunity to get your child(ren) signed up early before the program reaches full capacity.

We did hear the requests of the parents to provide longer program. We did consider going to 9 weeks. But after much debate our program for 2008 will remain a 6 week program. Beginning Monday June 23 and closing on Friday August 1.

All fees must be paid by Saturday May 31, 2008. All children with outstanding balances will be subject to loose their slot in this year's program. No more than 100 young people will be admitted and there are a limited number of young people per age group. These fees must be paid in a timely manner so that we can ensure the hiring of appropriate staff persons.

### On going Activities Programming

#### Christian Principle
